


OFF LEASH AREA EDMONDS DOG PARK GUIDELINES DURING COVID-19



The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends social distancing to prevent the spread of COVID-19. For your safety, please keep **AT LEAST 6 FEET AWAY** from others.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

- Enter at your own risk, the park is not sanitized.
- Do not enter park if you are exhibiting any illness symptoms or have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- Sanitize or wash your hands before and after entering the park.
- Spread out, limit groupings of people to 5 or fewer to promote 6' social distancing.
- Avoid physical contact like handshakes or high fives.
- Avoid touching gates, fences, benches, water faucets and trash cans with bare hands.
- Wear a mask when proper distancing cannot be accomplished.

The Off Leash Area Edmonds rules include but are not limited to:

- You must clean up after your dog(s) and deposit feces in the containers at the site (EMC 5.05.070).
- You are liable for the damage inflicted by your dog(s) (EMC 5.05.115).
- Dogs that come and play must be licensed and vaccinated (EMC 5.05.020).
