Draft Citywide Plan Update to Get Next Review June 10

(Edmonds - WA) Updating the Edmonds Comprehensive Plan will be the subject of a public open house on Wednesday, June 10th, from 6 to 7 p.m. in the Brackett Room, 3rd floor City Hall, 121 5th Ave N. in Edmonds. It will also be considered at a public hearing by the Planning Board at 7 pm in the Council Chambers at 250 5th Avenue N.

The open house will display maps and graphics about the citywide plan and the 2015 update process, with opportunities for feedback. At the 7:00 pm public hearing, the Planning Board will consider making a recommendation to the City Council for the proposed update.

The draft plan addresses key community needs for the years 2015-2035. It features broad goals and policies on sustainability, land use, transportation, housing, economic development, community culture, capital facilities, and other elements.

By state law, comprehensive plans must have a major review and be updated at least every 8 years. Review of the Edmonds Comprehensive Plan began about a year ago, with a focus on updating information and meeting the state deadline of mid-2015 to adopt needed changes.

After the Planning Board's recommendation, the City Council will have more meetings on the draft plan later this month and next month.
