Nature Discovery in the Classroom (Year-round)

Each program is a 1 hour Ranger-Naturalist **visit at your school** (unless otherwise indicated)
 \$73.00 per program for up to 30 students (no additional charges for travel within 20 miles roundtrip from Edmonds)

Birds Are Awesome! (1.25 hrs) (Jan—June only)	K-6	Bird characteristics, behavior, & interaction with habitat.
Life Cycles	K-3	An interactive look at developmental stages in plants, insects, frogs, and salmon.
Animal Adaptations	K-6	Ask scientific questions while examining skulls, pelts, and tracks to learn how animals adapt to their habitats.
Owls of Edmonds	K-3	An interactive look at our local owls and the adaptations and physiology that make them unique. Follow a local Barred Owl pair as they raise young in a local park through photos taken during a single nesting season.
NEW Outdoor Investigative Program (Year-round)		
Wildlife in Your Schoolyard <i>Includes data collection</i>	K-3	Discover which animals are using your schoolyard through a scientific investigation. What are the needs of these animals and where are those elements located? How could we expand and invite more wildlife into our schoolyards?

Discover the Forest at Yost Park (April—June)

Ranger-Naturalist led programs that **take place at Yost Park** in Edmonds
 \$96.00 per program for 1-30 students / \$144.00 per program for 31-45 students
 \$192 per program for up to 46-60 students.

Traditional Interpretive (1.5 hours)	K-6	Explore forest habitats, plants & animals using your five senses
Everyone Has a Habitat (1.5 hours)	1-4	Hands-on discovery of what animals need to live in the forest
Plants and Soil Ecology (2 hours) <i>NOW INCLUDES data collection and analysis.</i>	1-6	Investigative program that explores the interdependent cycle of life and death in the forest. Data collection enables students to understand the concept of ecological niches through comparison of plant distribution relative to soil characteristics.

Two-part Ranger-Naturalist led program, including a classroom visit and low-tide beach walk with a Ranger Naturalist.
