

**On the Fence**

**Seattle Artist Liz Tran creates "Afloat" for the On the Fence temporary public art installation project.**

City of Edmonds Arts Commission offers an opportunity for regional artists to create temporary outdoor art installations on the City owned fence south of ArtWorks at 201 Second Ave. South. The latest installation of brightly colored fishing floats is by Seattle artist Liz Tran.

Tying into Puget Sound's maritime history, while referencing the current issue of rising sea levels, Liz Tran's "Afloat" utilizes re-purposed fishing floats and buoys to inject an otherwise grey space with color and energy. Tran's work explores the shapes of nature and the psychedelic colors of her imagination. Created as a form of therapy during Seattle's long grey winters, she creates an atmosphere that is brighter, more playful, more colorful and more amiable than the world in which we exist.
