

A Resolution in Support of the Edmonds School District's Property Tax Levy Measures to be Placed on the February 5, 2002 Ballot


- Whereas,** the Edmonds School District Board of Directors has placed three property tax levy propositions on the February 5, 2002 special election ballot; and

- Whereas,** adequate financing of public education facilities and programs is essential to maintaining the quality of life in our community;


