

RESOLUTION NO. 1072

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, ADOPTING FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO SUCH EMERGENCY, AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT ENTERED INTO WITHOUT THE BENEFIT OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

WHEREAS, a storm drain failure has resulted in a sink hole and attendant damage to the Marina Beach Park parking area, and

WHEREAS, this damage resulted in an emergency condition requiring immediate construction necessary to stop the spread of the sinkhole, to adequately convey storm runoff and generally protect the public safety; and

WHEREAS, such situation constituted an emergency within the meaning of RCW 39.04.280(1)(c), now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby declares and confirms the existence of an emergency arising from this storm pipe failure.

Section 2. Municipal contracts entered into by the Mayor without the benefit of competitive bidding procedures are hereby ratified. Pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1)(c), the City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract change order with Blackwater Marine LLC, waiving competitive bidding procedures and confirming the award of all necessary contracts on behalf of the City necessary to address the emergency.
