

RESOLUTION NO. 1084

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE NATIONAL INCIDENT MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (NIMS)

WHEREAS, the City of Edmonds currently uses the Incident Management System as referred to in the National Incident Management System (NIMS); and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security has adopted the NIMS; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Homeland Security requires Federal, State, Territorial, Tribal, and Local government entities to adopt the NIMS; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the need for a single Incident Management System to be used by all co-operating and partner agencies and disciplines; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds the adoption of the National Incident Management System to be in the best interest of the City, now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The National Incident Management System is hereby adopted for use in all incidents, drills and exercises.

Section 2. The National Incident Management System (NIMS) Implementation Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is hereby adopted by reference to ensure the NIMS is fully incorporated into all emergency response plans, procedures, and policies, and to ensure that all personnel are appropriately trained in the NIMS.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Emergency Services Coordinating Agency and the City of Edmonds Disaster Coordinator.
