

**RESOLUTION NO. 1092**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, ADOPTING FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO SUCH EMERGENCY, AND RATIFYING A CONTRACT ENTERED INTO WITHOUT THE BENEFIT OF COMPETITIVE BIDDING.

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WHEREAS, a Sanitary Sewer pipeline failure has resulted in blockage of sewage flow from residences in the Ballinger area, and

WHEREAS, a sewer blockage poses a threat to public health and the environment, and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department does not have the necessary to correct the required construction equipment and machinery necessary to correct the situation, and

WHEREAS, such situation constituted an emergency within the meaning of RCW 39.04.280(1)(c), now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDMONDS, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby declares and confirms the existence of an emergency arising from this Sanitary Sewer pipeline failure.

Section 2. Municipal contracts entered into by the Mayor or Public Works Director without the benefit of competitive bidding procedures are hereby ratified. Pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1)(c), the City Council hereby authorizes the Public Works Director to execute a contract change order with Tri State Construction, Inc., waiving competitive bidding

procedures and confirming the award of all necessary contracts on behalf of the City necessary to address the emergency.
