Summary of Permit Completion Times

The Washington State Legislature passed ESHB 1458 in 2001 and HB 2811 in 2004. This legislation required certain jurisdictions, including Edmonds, to prepare annual reports summarizing how many land use permits were processed relative to a 120-day timeframe adopted by the Legislature. The following summarizes permit information for Edmonds during the year 2015.
