



### Which option is moving forward into the Marina Beach Master Plan?

The Preferred Master Plan Alternative is the result of a robust eight month public outreach process. The Preferred Master Plan Alternative synthesizes feedback from two open houses, two online open houses, Project Advisory Committee feedback, City Council and Planning Board comment, stakeholder and agency input.

In the Preferred Master Plan the off leash dog area remains in its current location. Park elements have been reconfigured to maintain the current uses. A reconfigured parking lot and turnaround will accommodate 50 standard stalls and 4 ADA stalls which maintains the exact number of stalls currently found at Marina Beach.

The central park space includes open lawn, a play area, picnic tables, a restroom, multiple overlooks, a personal watercraft staging area and plaza space for concessions. One bridge provides access to the dog park while a second bridge connects park users to an overlook area.

The reconfigured park and parking area meets ADA requirements.
