These kinds of things go in the garbage can.

Plastic:

Take-out containers



Styrofoam & packing peanuts

Caps & lids



Empty motor oil & antifreeze containers

Plastic bakery & meat trays



Plastic plates & utensils

Prescription vials



Stretch wrap

Clothes hangers

Candy wrappers & chip bags



Paper:

Food-soiled frozen food boxes



Disposable diapers



Ribbons & wrapping paper



Facial tissue, dirty or soiled paper

Food-soiled, wax & plastic-coated cardboard

Paper towels, plates or napkins

Hardback books*



**Tip: Remove covers & binding*

(put in garbage)-- pages are recyclable

Glass:

Mirrors & window glass

Ceramics & dishes

Broken glass

Incandescent light bulbs (*NO CFL bulbs*)



Metal:

Sharp or greasy metal

Caps, lids & rings

Clothes hangers

Hardened paint (*leave lid off*)*

**Tip: Use kitty litter or paint hardener to solidify latex paint.*



Miscellaneous:

Bagged pet waste & litter

CDs & CD cases
