

YARD WASTE & FOOD SCRAPS

These kinds of things go in your yard & food scrap cart.

Grass Clippings & leaves



Weeds



Houseplants (*no pots*)



Twigs, branches & roots from pruning



Tree branches

(*under 4 ft. long, 4 inch in diameter*)

Meat, fish, poultry, bones



Greasy pizza delivery boxes



Fruit & vegetable scraps; leftovers



Food soiled paper towels & napkins



Bread, pasta & grains



Shredded paper (*layered*) (*no plastic*)



Eggshells & nutshells



Paper grocery bags containing food scraps

Coffee filters & grounds



Paper egg cartons



Teabags & tea leaves



Paper berry cartons



Uncoated paper plates & cups*



Uncoated paper food wrap*



Uncoated paper food bags*



*Tip: *Uncoated paper does not have a shiny surface.*

Recycle food. It's easy to do.

- Keep container near your sink
- Add food scraps and food soiled paper
- When full, empty into your yard waste cart
