

Sunset Avenue Walkway

The City of Edmonds will be presenting a preliminary design concept for the Sunset Avenue Walkway Project at 6pm, December 18, 2013 in the Edmonds Library Plaza Room, 650 Main Street.

The Sunset Avenue Walkway is being developed to provide an all-weather, ADA accessible, and multi-modal (bicycle & pedestrian) route from Bell Street north through Caspers Street with connection to 3rd Avenue North. The goal of the project is to improve the quality and safety of public access and the enjoyment of Olympic Mountain and Puget Sound views. This can be accomplished by extending the City's existing waterfront trail another 2,500 feet north where it will link to the City's existing sidewalk system.

The City was successful in securing a \$159,000 federal grant to help fund the project design. This section of Sunset Avenue is heavily used by pedestrian and other non-motorized traffic. The project will greatly reduce conflicts between pedestrians and vehicles.
