EDMONDS PLANNING BOARD SEEKS NEW MEMBER

(Edmonds - WA) The City of Edmonds is seeking one (1) resident interested in participating on the Edmonds Planning Board for the position of **Alternate**. The Planning Board serves as an advisory board to the City Council on rezones, comprehensive planning, Community Development Code amendments, and other land use issues. The alternate member attends all meetings and participates in all discussions and work sessions; the alternate acts as a regular voting member when one of the regular members is absent.

The Planning Board meets the second and fourth Wednesdays of each month at 7 p.m. in the Public Safety Complex. Volunteer board members serve for a four-year term and are eligible for appointment to a second four-year term.
