### **200<sup>th</sup> St SW Road Closure**

*Between 76<sup>th</sup> Avenue West and 80<sup>th</sup> Avenue West*

**(Edmonds – WA)** The City’s contractor has encountered unexpected soil conditions during deep excavation for the new sewer main in 200<sup>th</sup> St SW, west of 76<sup>th</sup> Avenue as part of the City’s annual sewermain replacement project.

**Due to soil conditions and public safety, 200<sup>th</sup> St SW between 76<sup>th</sup> Ave W and 80<sup>th</sup> Ave West is closed to through traffic until the new sewermain is completed, expected to be July 23, 2014. Local access will remain open to residents, first responders, mail, garbage, and recycling services for the duration of construction in that area.**
