SUNSET WALKWAY SURVEY

The City of Edmonds is conducting a survey to evaluate public attitudes concerning the temporary walkway installed on Sunset Avenue, so that the City may evaluate future options. The survey will run through November 20, 2015.

The Sunset Avenue Walkway is being developed to provide an all-weather, ADA accessible, and multi-modal (bicycle & pedestrian) route from Bell Street north through Caspers Street with connection to 3rd Avenue North. The goal of the project is to improve the quality and safety of public access and the enjoyment of Olympic Mountain and Puget Sound views. This can be accomplished by extending the City's existing waterfront trail another 2,500 feet north where it will link to the City's existing sidewalk system.
