A public meeting will take place on **Thursday, November 5th, 2015** from 5pm to 8pm in the gym at College Place Elementary (20401 76th Ave W, Lynnwood, WA 98036), regarding the ***Bike-2-Health project***. The cities of Lynnwood, Mountlake Terrace, and Edmonds have launched Bike2Health, an effort to increase bicycling connectivity, make bicycling safer and improve access to health and wellness choices. Learn about the new bike lanes, where they are and what they connect to, and when they will be constructed. The preliminary design plans for this project have recently been completed, consisting of completing critical bicycle missing links in the regional bicycle map (connecting Mountlake Terrace, Lynnwood, and Edmonds). A map of the proposed network is identified by going to the following website: www.verdanthealth.org/bike2health.

The new bike lanes are proposed on 212th St. SW from 84th Ave W to 72nd Ave W and on 76th Ave W from 220th St. SW to 196th St. SW. Pavement striping modifications will result in the following changes at certain locations: (1) reduction in width of travel lanes; (2) road diets (4-lane to 3-lane conversion with two-way left turn lane); and (3) removal of on-street parking and addition of two-way left turn lane. You are invited to participate in this public meeting and provide comments on the proposed improvements. We look forward to seeing you there.
