Housing Commission to Meet October 10, 2019

The Edmonds Citizens' Housing Commission will meet for the second time on Thursday, October 10, at 6:30 pm, in the Brackett Room, third floor of City Hall, 121 5th Avenue N. The public can attend in person or by viewing via a live-stream.

Agenda materials for the October 10 meeting will be posted by the end of October 7 on the City's "Meeting Agendas" webpage (<http://edmondswa.ig2.com/Citizens/default.aspx>). The agenda is expected to include discussion of the Commission's work plan and goals for future community engagement.

Regular monthly meetings of the Housing Commission are scheduled for the second Thursday of each month, starting at 6:30 pm, through the year 2020. The location for meetings in November and beyond is still being determined. All Commission meetings will be video-recorded and available on the City website.

As part of the project, additional public events and activities will be planned to reach the broad community.

The Housing Commission is comprised of 15 members, with two members appointed by each City Council person and one member appointed by the Mayor, from different parts of the city. Each elected official also appointed one alternate, for a total of eight.
