CITY SEEKS TWO NEW ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION MEMBERS

(Edmonds, WA) - There are currently two open positions on the Citizens Economic Development Commission (CEDC) for which the City seeks interested applicants.

“Promoting economic activity in Edmonds enhances our quality of life and creates jobs,” commented Mayor Mike Nelson. “Our Economic Development Commissioners provide valuable advice on many issues before the City Council, staff, and the Mayor.”

The appointed Commissioners will serve in a volunteer capacity for initial partial terms (one running until 3/31/21, and the other until 3/31/22), at which time the appointed Commissioner may request reappointment to subsequent, full, two-year terms. Both currently open positions will be filled through direct appointment by the Mayor.

Mayor Nelson particularly encourages women, people of color, and other minorities to apply for service on this Commission.
