



## OFFICIAL STREET MAP AMENDMENT

The Official Street Map of the City of Edmonds shows all streets, street names, right-of-ways, and required dedications. In order to change any provision of the map, an application for an amendment to the Official Street Map must be filed with the Planning Division. All applications are subject to review by the Hearing Examiner and the City Council.

### Criteria

Proposed changes to the Official Street Map are reviewed on the basis of the following:

1. The purposes of the Comprehensive Policy Plan.
2. The purposes of the Comprehensive Street Plan
3. The purposes of the Official Street Map.

### Application Procedure

1. Prepare and submit an application for an amendment to the Official Street Map. The Planning Division has the forms and will assist you with any questions you may have. Your application must include the following:
  - a. Completed and signed application form.
  - b. Environmental Checklist if applicable.
  - c. Four copies of a map of the area involved, showing north point and scale. The map must be no larger than 11" X 17".
  - d. A petition containing the signatures of local residents supporting the application may be attached.
  - e. Fee (see Fee Sheet).

time on the electrofusion processor. Electrofusion couplings shall be rated for a minimum pressure of 200 psi.

3. Fittings for HDPE pipe shall be made from the same resin as the pipe, and fully pressure rated to the 200 psi pressure rating of the pipe. Bends shall be mitered assemblies fused with angular cut pipe segments, with minimum number of segments as follows:

30 to 45 degrees – 3 segments

50 to 70 degrees – 4 segments

4. Hydrostatic Pressure Test: The first sentence of the paragraph of Section 7-09.3(23) shall be deleted and replaced with the following:

Hydrostatic test pressure shall be 200 psi measured at the lowest point of the section of pipe being tested.

**9-30.2(5) PVC Schedule 80 Pipe (REVISION)**

PVC Schedule 80 pipe shall be manufactured from a Type I, Grade I Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) compound with a Cell Classification of 12454 per ASTM D1784. The pipe shall be manufactured in strict compliance to ASTM D1785 and D2665 (where applicable), consistently meeting and/or exceeding the Quality Assurance test requirements of these standards with regard to material, workmanship, burst pressure, flattening, and extrusion quality. The pipe shall be manufactured in the USA, using domestic materials, by an ISO 9001 certified manufacturer. Standard lengths of pipe sizes 6-inch and larger shall be beveled each end by the pipe manufacturer. All pipe shall be stored indoors after production at the manufacturing site until shipped from factory.

**9-30.3(1) Gate Valves (REVISION)**

DELETE THIS SECTION IN ITS ENTIRETY AND SUBSTITUTE WITH THE FOLLOWING:

Gate valves, 2-inches through 12-inches, shall be of the resilient wedge type, and shall conform to the requirements of AWWA C-509 or C-515. All interior various parts, including the interior of the gate or wedge shall be coated with fusion bonded epoxy with a minimum thickness of 8 ml. Said coating shall be non-toxic, impart no taste to water and shall conform to AWWA C-550.

Gate valves, smaller than 2-inches for buried service, shall be iron bodied, non-rising stem with bronze double wedge disc rated for service at 300

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2. Public Hearing. You will be assigned and notified of a hearing date as soon as the application is determined to be complete.

Hearing Examiner meetings are held at 9:30 a.m. on the first and third Thursdays of each month unless otherwise noted, in the City Hall – 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Meeting Room, No. 304, 121 5<sup>th</sup> Ave. N., Edmonds, and are open to the public. You or your representative must appear at the hearing so the Hearing Examiner can ask questions concerning your application. Should you or your representative be unable to attend the meeting, or if you wish to withdraw your application, please notify the Planning Division in writing at least four days before the meeting. The Hearing Examiner issues his recommendation ten working days following the conclusion of the hearing.

3. The City Council considers the Hearing Examiner's recommendation at a public hearing. The Council may approve, disapprove or modify the requested amendment.
4. Upon approval of an application by the City Council, the adopting ordinance will direct the Public Works Director to incorporate the change on the Official Street Map.
