Edmonds Climate Protection Committee seeks new members

(Edmonds – WA) The Mayor's "Citizens Committee on U.S. Mayors Climate Protection Agreement" is seeking volunteers to fill two openings. The committee consists of five non-paid volunteers.

The Climate Protection Committee generally meets on the first Thursday of each month to work on environmental, energy, and sustainability issues pertinent to Edmonds and its citizens. The citizen members work with City of Edmonds staff to formulate ideas that are then presented to the City Council for possible consideration and implementation. Currently the committee is finalizing a Climate Action Plan.

There are no specific qualifications needed to apply for this position; however, an interest in climate or environmental issues and how they relate to Edmonds is preferred, as well as the ability to attend 9 a.m. meetings. Edmonds residency is not required. Applicants will be interviewed by the Mayor, and the selected candidate will be appointed by the Mayor.
