HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION SEEKS NEW MEMBER

(Edmonds - WA) The City of Edmonds is seeking an interested citizen for the Historic Preservation Commission. Applicants must reside within the city of Edmonds, have a demonstrated interest or competence in historic preservation, and possess qualities of impartiality and broad judgment.

The commission identifies and actively encourages conservation of the city's historic resources by maintaining a register of historic places and reviewing proposed changes to register properties to raise community awareness of the city's history and historic resources. It serves as the city's primary resource in matters of history, historic planning, and preservation. The commission meets the second Thursday of each month at 4 p.m. at City Hall.
