June 23rd was a perfect summer day to celebrate the grand opening of Edmonds' newly renovated Civic Center Playfield Park in downtown.

A focal point in the park is the large shade structure, next to the restrooms. Seattle artist Clark Wiegman used the shade structure and adjoining wall of the restrooms as a canvas to create a dynamic installation titled *cascadia*.

Described as a love letter to the Salish Sea, cascadia invites park visitors to contemplate their place within the natural world. The sculptural suspension, lifeboat, is a human-powered archetype vessel navigating a luminous seawall, a graphically designed aerial view of the Salish Sea and Puget Sound. Together, lifeboat and seawall elicit a feeling of belonging to a larger bioregion and the care for our shared environs.



The web of life design of lifeboat's hull was created from suggestions submitted by members of the Edmonds community of plants and animals in our region that might be incorporated into the design.

Clark Wiegman's work explores ways we may experience nature through cultural frames. Over the past three decades, he's created projects for a variety of civic contexts throughout North America.
