A CHANCE TO SHOWCASE ART: EAC LOOKING FOR EXHIBITS!

Edmonds, WA – The City of Edmonds Arts Commission (EAC) invite Puget Sound region visual artists to apply to exhibit their work in the Edmonds Sno-Isle Library and the Frances Anderson Center Art Display Case in 2027. Exhibits are rotated on a quarterly basis.

Original two-dimensional works and small to medium sized three-dimensional works will be considered. Mediums may include, but are not limited to oils, pastels, watercolors, sketches, lithographs and other print processes, sculpture, fiber art, jewelry, glass art, photography, metal works and ceramics. The goal of the EAC Visual Art Exhibit Program is to provide a forum where the public can develop an appreciation and understanding of the visual arts through the exhibition of original artworks, and to provide artists with an opportunity to exhibit their work.

Edmonds Sno-Isle Library Art Wall features quarterly rotating exhibits of solo and group shows. Located at the entrance of the library, this public space features a wire suspension system with fixed lighting for 5-8 two-dimensional framed artworks, depending on framed size. All work is required to be framed or mounted and wired for hanging. Artists must deliver and pick up their work at a mutually agreed time. City staff are required to hang exhibits in the library.

Frances Anderson Center Art Display Case is a built-in case with lockable sliding glass doors that provides a secure space for two- and three-dimensional work. The case features quarterly rotating exhibits of solo and group shows. Dimensions are 8'9" W x 5'3" H x 23" D, and is equipped with fixed lighting, ventilation and a power outlet. Pedestals are available. Artists are required to set up their own exhibit.
